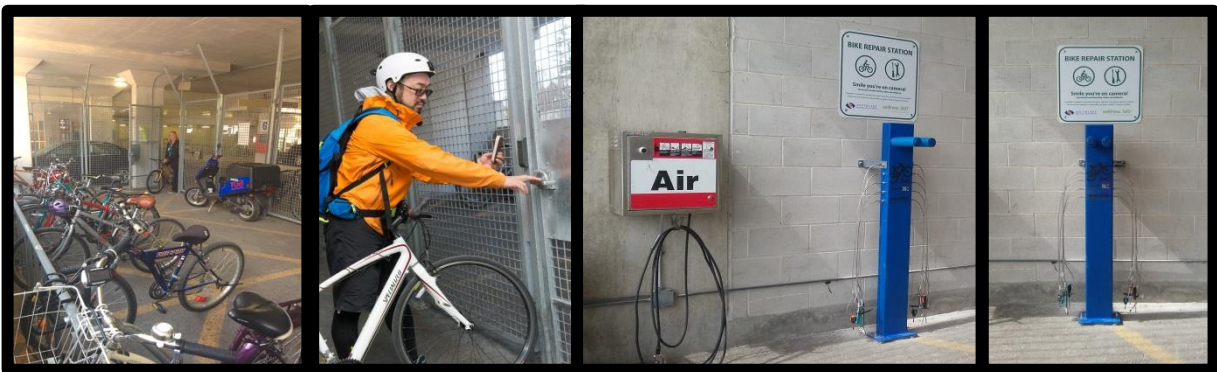


A big shout-out to our Smart Commute member businesses Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) and Southlake Regional Health Centre who have both recently improved cycling infrastructure at their worksites!



14 % of LSRCA employees cycled to work on Bike to Work Day and parked in their brand new bike shed. The shed easily accommodated all the bikes with a lot of room to spare. The shed is secured with a combination lock keypad. This was a cost-efficient project as they incorporated some left-over materials from other projects and recruited LSRCA staff to construct the shed.



In addition to several bike racks on the property, Southlake has a secure bike cage which is locked at all times and has video surveillance. Staff use their ID badges to access the cage. Right now, Southlake staff are researching ways to optimize the bike cage space in order to accommodate more bikes. In addition, the hospital has an on-site air pump and recently installed a permanent bike repair station, the first one among all our member businesses!
